NHS Minor Ailment Scheme and Pharmacy First Scheme

Did you know you can now get treatment for seven common conditions directly from your local pharmacy, without the need for a GP appointment or prescription? Conditions they can offer prescription medicine for are:

- impetigo (aged 1 year and over)
- infected insect bites (aged 1 year and over)
- earache (aged 1 to 17 years)
- sore throat (aged 5 years and over)
- sinusitis (aged 12 years and over)
- urinary tract infections (UTIs) (women aged 16 to 64 years)

Head lice

There have has been several outbreaks of head lice already this term in different year groups.

shingles (aged 18 years and over)

Children, people on certain benefits and people with medical exemptions can get free medicine from a pharmacist under the Minor Ailment Scheme.



- Keeping long hair tied back at school is one way to avoid catching head lice
- If everyone checks regularly and treats affected children immediately, we can stop outbreaks spreading.
- It is important that children are checked weekly for head lice by wet combing with a fine-toothed head lice comb and lots of conditioner
- If you find any lice or nits, you can treat them by regular wet combing. If that is not effective, you may need to use medicated lotions or sprays available from a pharmacy or supermarket
