



Anti-Bullying Children's Charter

We do not tolerate bullying of any kind at Ivydale School. Any incident of apparent bullying is investigated and tackled. All children at Ivydale work together with adults to stop bullying. Children in Year 4 worked together with staff, parents and representatives of Kidscape to write this charter. Year 4 children will share this charter with other children in the school and will work with everyone in the school against bullying of all forms.

We want to encourage...

- ...equality between boys and girls, children of all races and religions
- ...people to feel safe
- ...understanding of all our school values like love, kindness, respect, sharing, friendship
- ...people to feel proud to be themselves
- ...children to feel confident to tell an adult if they see or hear any bullying or if they are worried about someone being bullied

We want to stop...

- ...physical bullying which includes punching, kicking, fighting, pushing, play fighting, stealing and any threatening behaviour
- ...emotional bullying which includes spreading rumours, excluding people, teasing people because of perceived differences, mocking/mimicking, unkind teasing, laughing when someone makes a mistake
- ...verbal bullying which includes name calling, arguing, friends falling out, calling people gay, using offensive language that is racist, sexist, homophobic, or against people with special needs
- ...cyberbullying which includes instant messaging, unkind comments online or via computer games such as minecraft
